OVERVIEW

UPCOMING WORKSHOP DATES & SUBJECTS :

June 11, 12, 13 : STAGE COMBAT

Stage combat is a specialized technique in theatre designed to create the illusion of physical combat without causing harm to the performers. It is employed in live stage plays as well as operatic and ballet productions. The term is also used informally to describe fight choreography for other production media including film and television. It is a common field of study for actors and dancers and is closely related to the practice of stunts.

June 18, 19, 20 : DOGME 95 FILMMAKING

Dogme 95 is a minimalistic style of filmmaking aimed at taking away the reliance on technology and post-production, and returning the art to a more pure level. The emphasis on purity forces the filmmakers to focus on the actual story and on the actors' performances. The audience may also be more engaged as they do not have over-production to alienate them from the narrative, themes, and mood.

July 9, 10, 11 : CONTACT IMPROV

Contact Improvisation is a dance form based on the communication between two or more moving bodies that are in physical contact and their combined relationship to the physical laws that govern their motion—gravity, momentum, inertia. It is a free play with balance, self-correcting the wrong moves and reinforcing the right ones, bringing forth a physical, emotional truth about a shared moment of movement that leaves the participants informed, centered, and enlivened.

July 16, 17, 18 : FREE FORM EXPRESS

Free Form Express is an originally conceived workshop designed to serve as a stress relieving outlet, as well as a creative expression. Free Form Express will include mass canvases, outdoor sites, music, and implemented challenges all geared towards getting your mind off of the daily monotonies and cleansing the mental palette.
